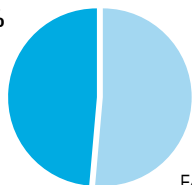

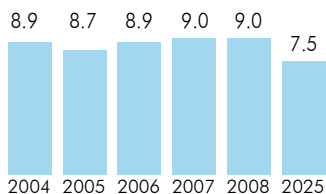

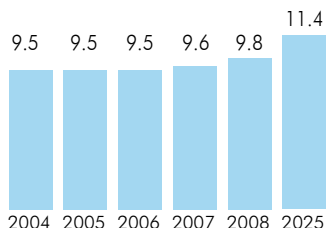

Death rate (deaths per 1,000 inhabitants)



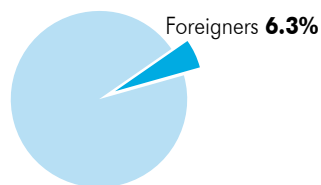

1<sup>st</sup> January 2008, % foreigners volume



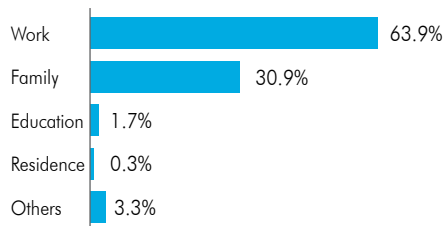

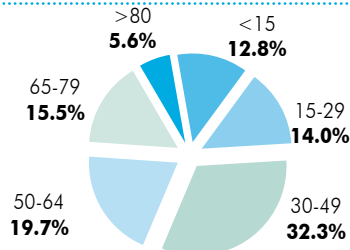

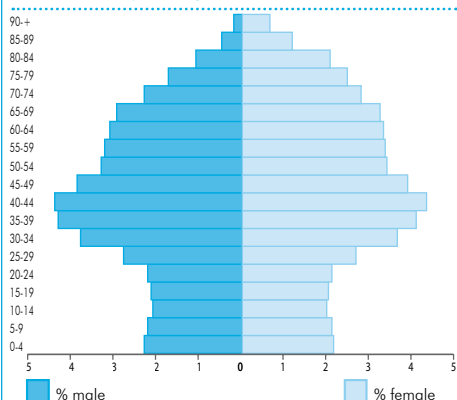
## RESIDENT POPULATION BY AGE

1<sup>st</sup> January 2008, % volume



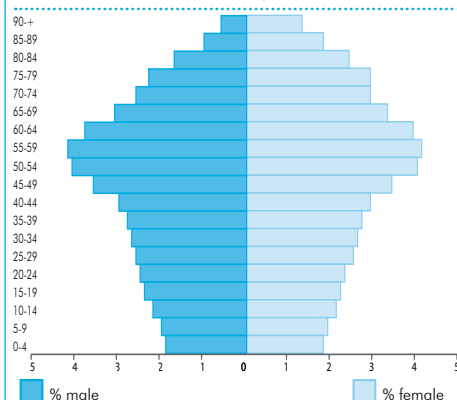
## RESIDENT POPULATION BY GENDER

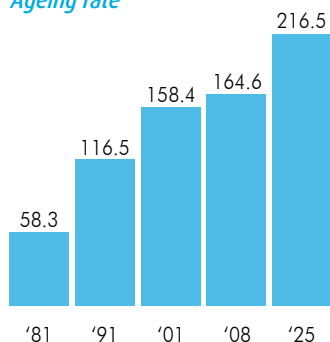
Projection to 1<sup>st</sup> January 2025, % values



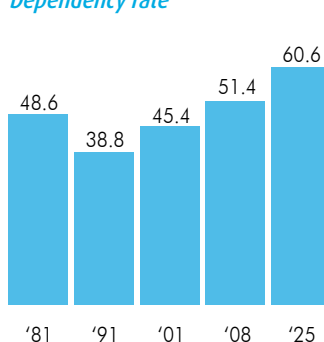

**Death rate:** ratio between the number of deaths and the average resident population (per 1,000 inhabitants).

**Ageing rate:** ratio of population aged 65 and over to population aged 0-14.

**Dependency rate:** ratio of non-working age population (0-14; 65 and over) to working age population (15-64).

**Residence permits:** refer to all foreigners holding a valid document issued by the Italian police authorities.

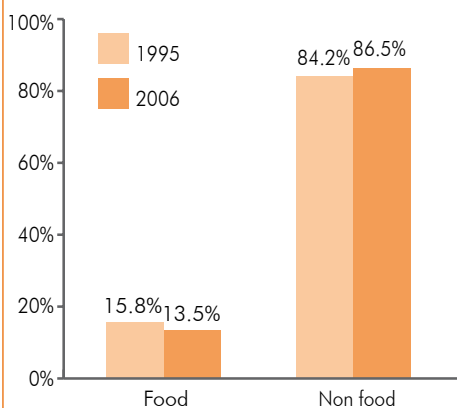

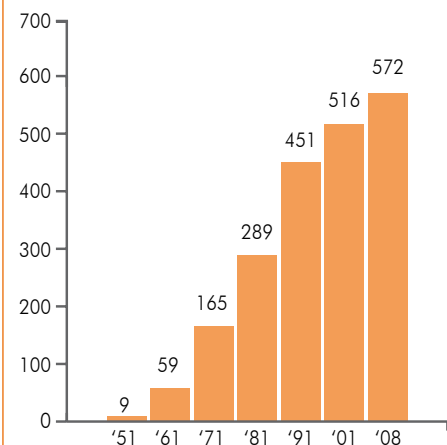
### INTERNAL FINAL CONSUMPTION BY TYPE

### SOME DEFINITIONS

**Available households income:** total incomes (salaries, earnings, pensions, rents, etc.) of each member of household aged 16 and over.

**Available income per capita:** available income of each member of household.

**Household equity:** household wealth based on the value of real assets (buildings, lands, enterprises, durable goods and jewelry) and financial assets (currency, deposits, shares, stocks).

**Internal final consumption:** goods and services bought or self-consumed by the household to satisfy their needs.

**Large-scale retail trade:** supermarkets, department stores, superstores, large non-food stores, minimarkets.

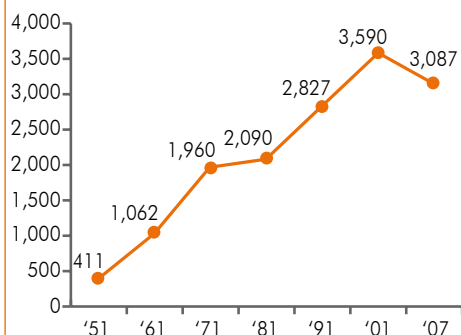
### DEATHS BY GENDER

**Local Health Service:** public hospitals and accredited private clinics.

**Hospital stay:** period of time spent in a Local Health Service.

**Average stay:** ratio of number of days of stay to number of hospital stays.

**Hospitalisation rate:** ratio of number of hospital stays to resident population (yearly average). It represents the average number of hospital stays per 1000 inhabitants.

**Hospital bed occupancy rate:** ratio between the real days of stay to potential days of stay (per 100). It represents the % share of real hospital beds used in relation to the available equipment.

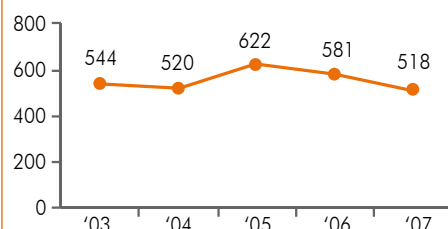

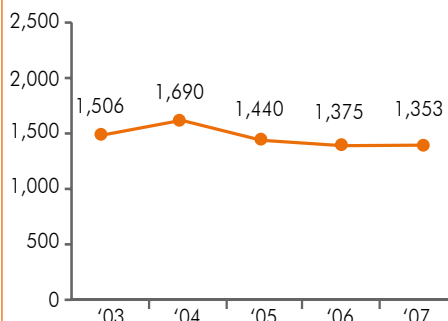

**Books:** non-periodical work in no less than five pages, in one or more volumes, booklets or issues published as a whole or in parts during the same year.

**Editions:** total number of copies of a book printed at the same time and in the same form.

**Performances:** shows or other entertainment events, non-commercial performances, planned with the issuing of a ticket (free shows are not included in this category).

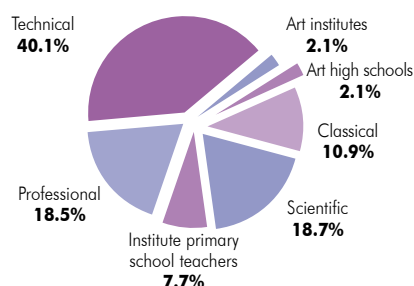

## SOME DEFINITIONS

**School system:** divided into six levels: pre-school education, primary, middle school, high schools, adult education (non-university), university.

**University enrolments:** students enrolled at University in an Academic year, irrespective of the year of the course.

**Graduates:** students obtaining a qualification after the first three-year university cycle (3 years), a two-year university cycle (3+2 years), a "unique" formula university course (5 or 6 years).

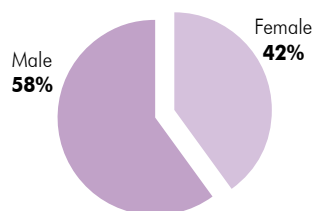

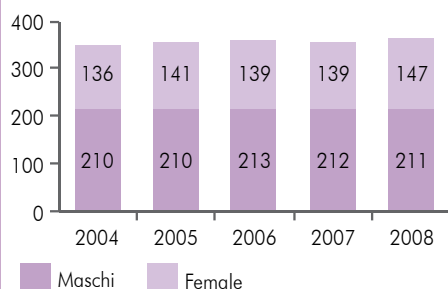
## LABOUR FORCE BY GENDER

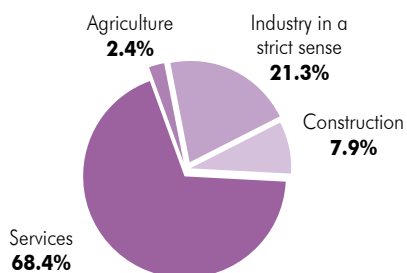

## SOME DEFINITIONS

**Labour force:** employees and job-seekers.

**Employees:** all individuals aged 15 and over in the reference week who have carried out at least 1 hour of paid work or are absent from work for holidays or illness.

**Job-seekers:** all unemployed individuals aged 15-64 who have carried out at least 1 active action of job search during the 30 days preceding the survey or they will begin work in 3 months and are available to work in the 2 weeks following the interview.

**Activity rate:** ratio of people in the labour force to the corresponding reference population.

**Employment rate:** ratio of employees to the corresponding reference population.

**Unemployment rate:** ratio of job-seekers to labour force.

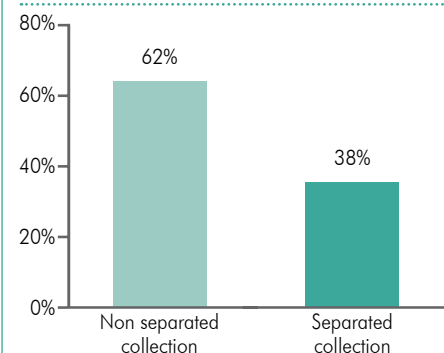

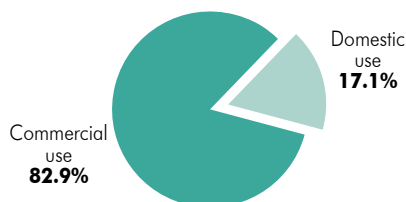

**Municipal waste:** household waste, non-hazardous waste, waste from street, parks and gardens, and from cemeterial activities.

**Separate collection:** collection of municipal waste assembled into homogeneous groups.

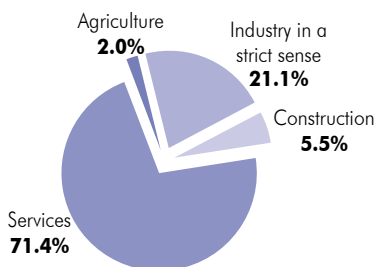

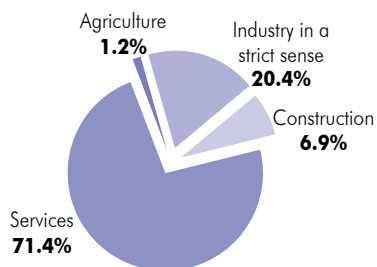
## VALUE ADDED AT BASIC PRICES BY BRANCH

**Gross Domestic Product per capita:** ratio between the value of final products and services of a country in a year and the average population of that country in the same year.

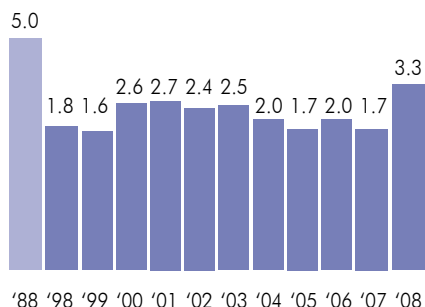

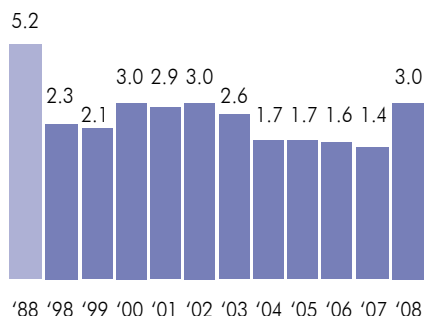
## CONSUMER PRICE INDEX FOR BLUE AND WHITE COLLAR WORKERS HOUSEHOLDS (CPI)

### SOME DEFINITIONS

**Consumer price index:** measures the changes in the price of a basket of goods and services through time.

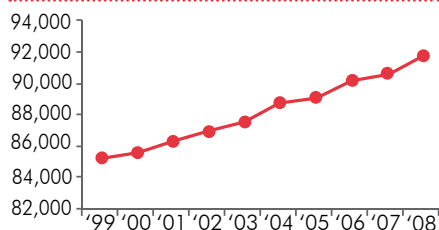
Istat adopts **three consumer price indexes:**

- **Consumer price index for the whole nation (NIC):** covers the consumption of the country's entire present population;
- **Consumer price index for blue and white collar workers households (CPI):** covers the consumption of households having an employee as a reference person;
- **Harmonised EU consumer price index (HICP):** refers to the general community of households present but the survey is restricted to the consumption of goods and services in the various EU countries with comparable prices.

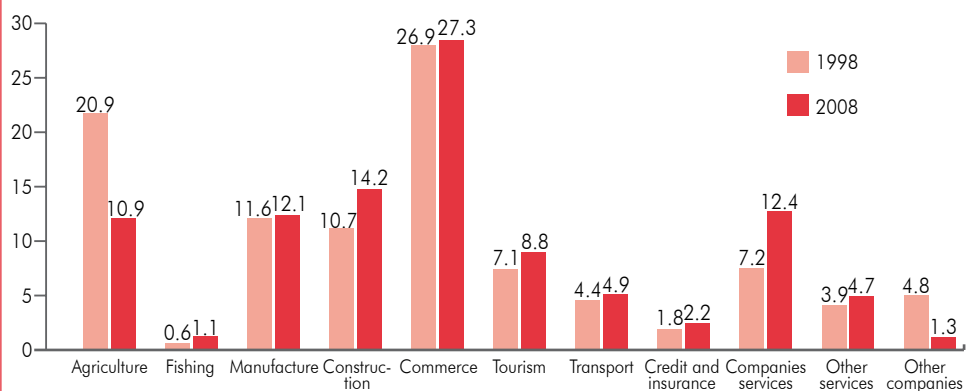
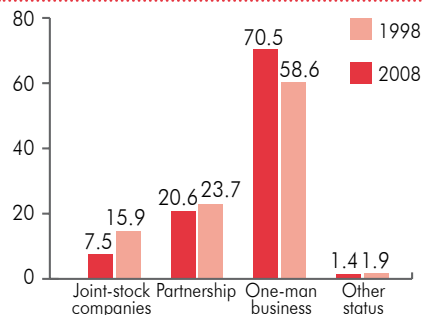

**Female enterprise:** enterprise with a female presence over 50%.

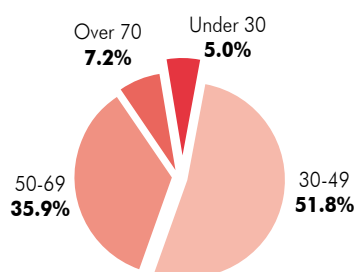
### ENTREPRENEURS BY GENDER

**Entrepreneur:** a person who holds a post in the company (owner, partner, administrator, ...).

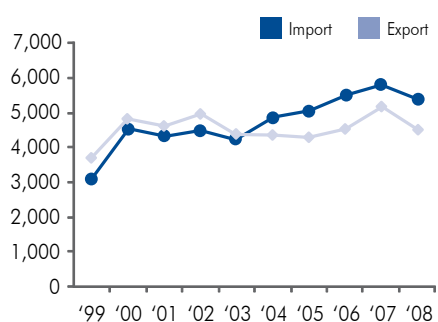

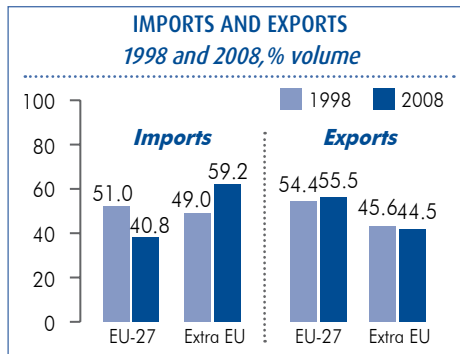

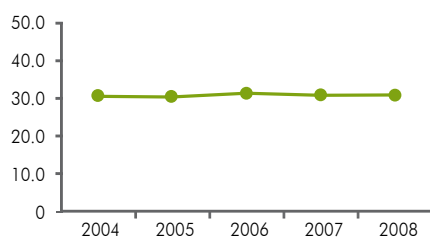

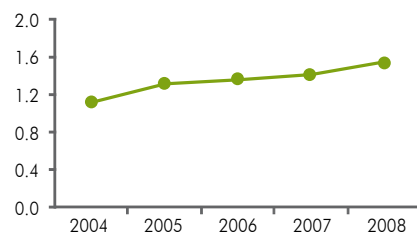

### PASSENGER TRAFFIC (millions of passengers)

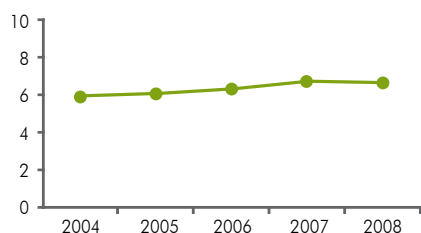


## PORT OF CHIOGGIA: goods handled 2004-2008, millions of tonnes

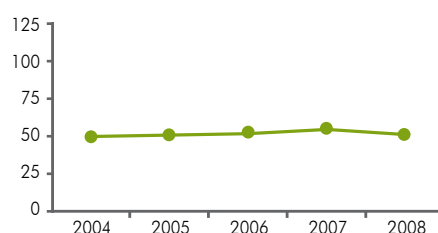


## VENICE AIRPORT (2004-2008)
