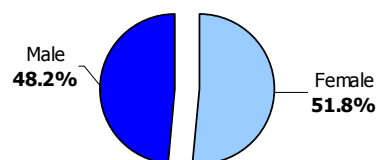

Death rate (deaths per 1,000 inhabitants)



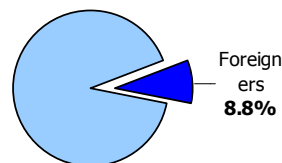

1st January 2011, % foreigners volume



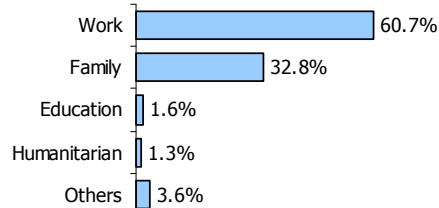

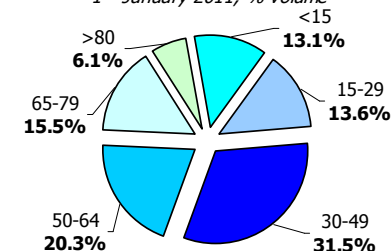

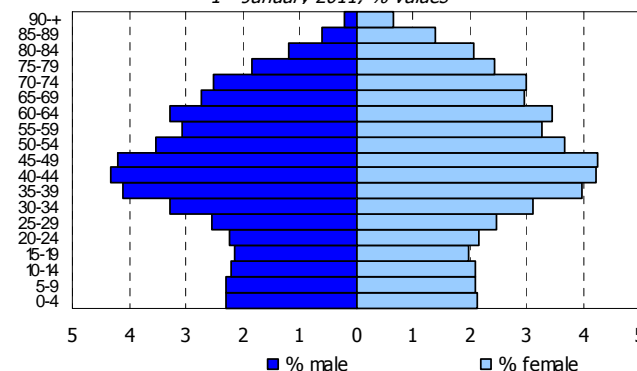
RESIDENT POPULATION BY AGE

1st January 2011, % values

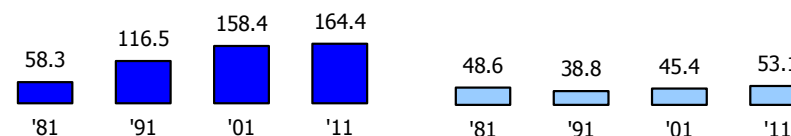

Residence permits: refer to all foreigners holding a valid document issued by the Italian police authorities.

Ageing rate: ratio of population aged 65 and over to population aged 0-14.

Dependency rate: ratio of non-working age population (0-14; 65 and over) to working age population (15-64).

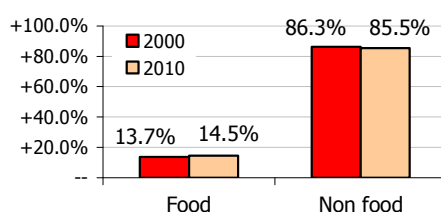

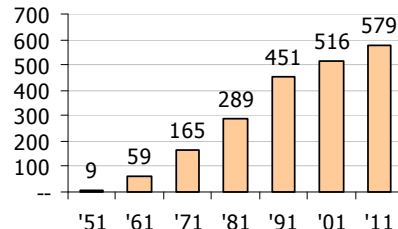
INTERNAL FINAL CONSUMPTION BY TYPE

Some definitions

Available households income: total incomes (salaries, earnings, pensions, rents, etc.) of each member of household aged 16 and over.

Available income per capita: available income of each member of household.

Household equity: household wealth based on the value of real assets (buildings, lands, enterprises, durable goods and jewelry) and financial assets (currency, deposits, shares, stocks).

Internal final consumption: goods and services bought or self-consumed by the household to satisfy their needs.

Large-scale retail trade: supermarkets, department stores, superstores, large non-food stores, minimarkets.

Average stay: ratio of number of days of stay to number of hospital stays.

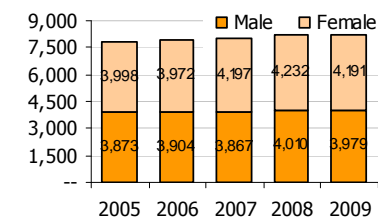
Hospital bed occupancy rate: ratio between the real days of stay to potential days of stay (per 100). It represents the % share of real hospital beds used in relation to the available equipment.

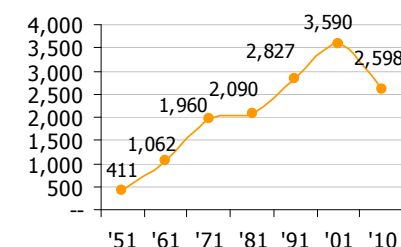
DEATHS BY GENDER

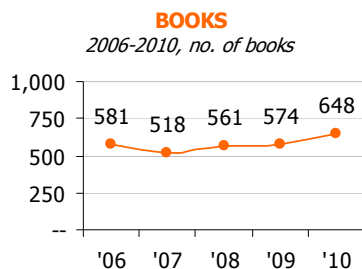

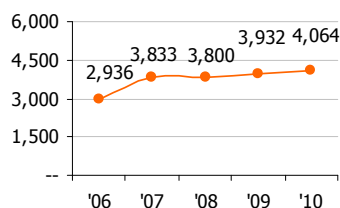

Editions: total number of copies of a book printed at the same time and in the same form.

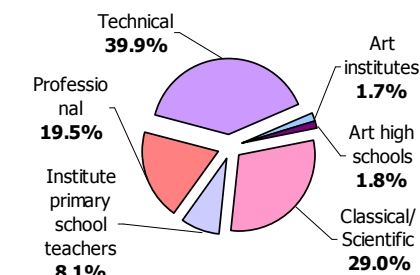

Some definitions

University enrolments: students enrolled at University in an Academic year, irrespective of the year of the course.

Graduates: students obtaining a qualification after the first three-year university cycle (3 years), a two-year university cycle (3+2 years), a "unique" formula university course (5 or 6 years).

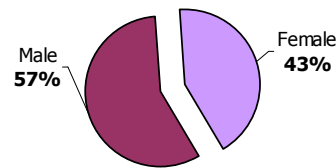

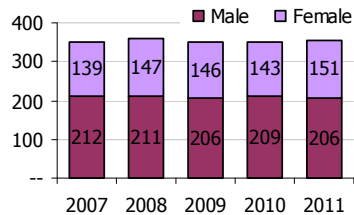
LABOUR FORCE BY GENDER

2011, % volume



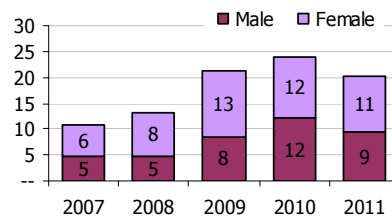
EMPLOYEES

2007-2011, thousands of persons



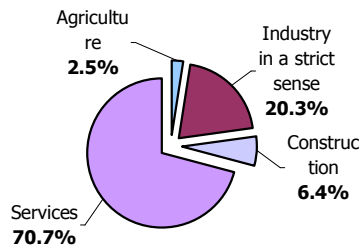
JOB-SEEKERS

Some definitions

Labour force: employees and job-seekers.

Employees: all individuals aged 15 and over in the reference week who have carried out at least 1 hour of paid work or are absent from work for holidays or illness.

Activity rate: ratio of people in the labour force to the corresponding reference population.

Employment rate: ratio of employees to the corresponding reference population.

Job-seekers: all unemployed individuals aged 15-64 who have carried out at least 1 active action of job search during the 30 days preceding the survey or they will begin work in 3 months and are available to work in the 2 weeks following the interview.

Unemployment rate: ratio of job-seekers to labour force.

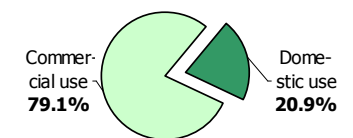

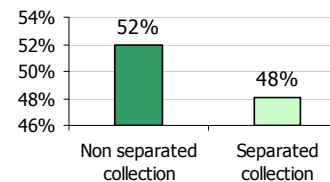

Some definitions

Agricultural Area in Use: surface used for agricultural crops.

Agricultural production at basic prices: value of goods and services of the agricultural enterprises obtained from the agricultural activity (contributions included and product taxes excluded).

Municipal waste: household waste, non-hazardous waste, waste from streets, parks and gardens, and from cemeterial activities.

Separate collection: collection of municipal waste assembled into homogeneous groups.

Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE): loosely discarded, surplus, obsolete, or broken electrical and electronic devices.

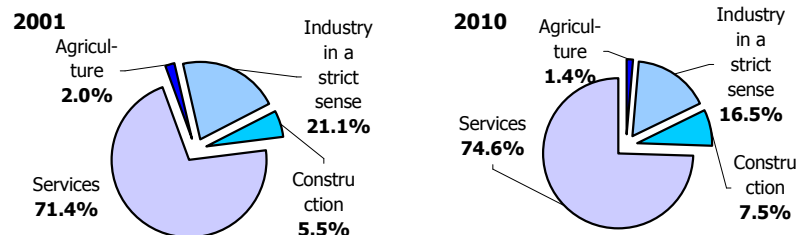

Gross Domestic Product per capita: ratio between the value of final products and services of a country in a year and the average population of that country in the same year.

Gross Domestic Product (GDP): final result of the production activity of resident producer units; sum of gross value added of all resident producers at basic prices plus taxes minus subsidies on products.

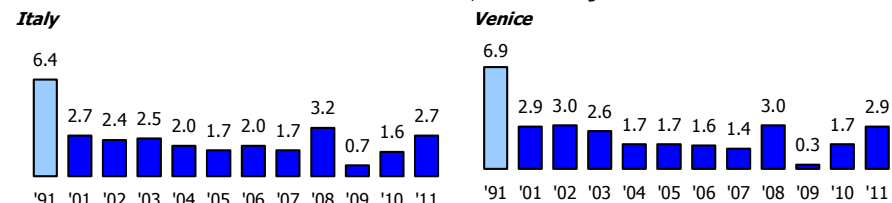

Some definitions

Consumer price index: measures the changes in the price of a basket of goods and services through time. Istat adopts **three consumer price indexes:**

- **Consumer price index for the whole nation (NIC):** covers the consumption of the country's entire present population;
- **Consumer price index for blue and white collar workers households (CPI):** covers the consumption of households having an employee as a reference person;
- **Harmonised EU consumer price index (HICP):** refers to the general community of households present; but the survey is restricted to the consumption of goods and services in the various EU countries with comparable prices.

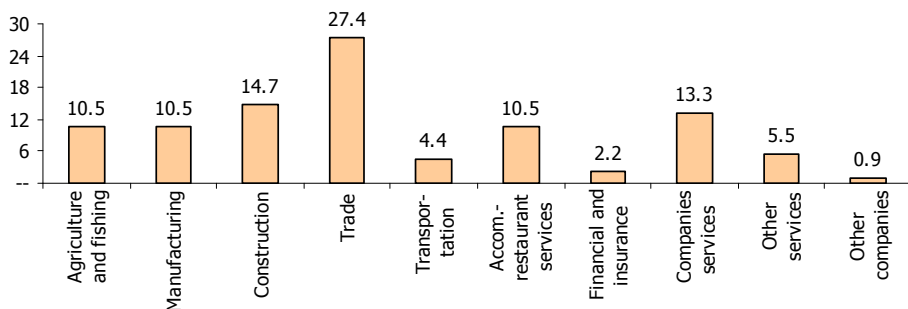

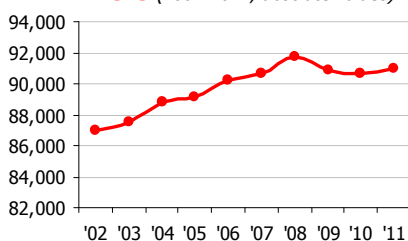

Female enterprise: enterprise that have over 50% of female members.

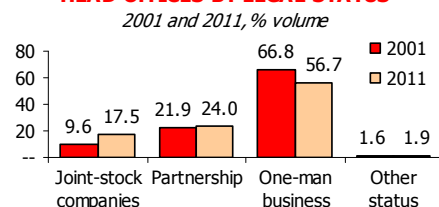
Young enterprise: enterprise that have over 50% of young members (under 35 years old).

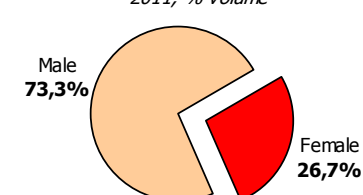

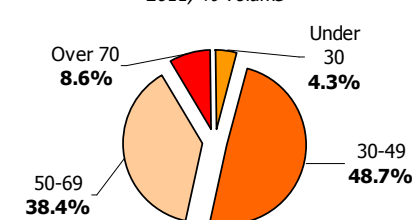
ENTREPRENEURS BY GENDER

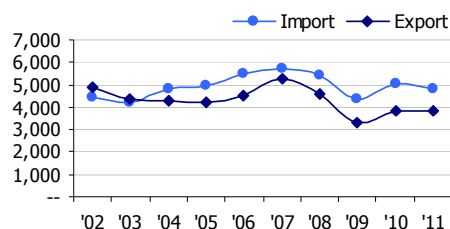

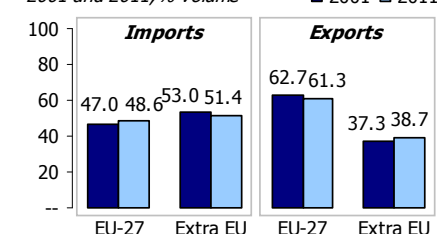

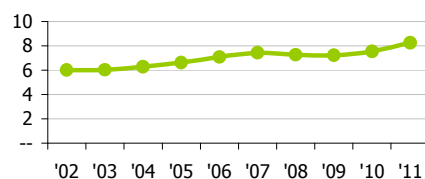
TOURIST NIGHTS BY ORIGIN

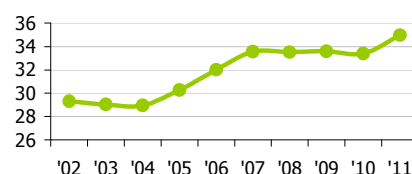


TOURIST FLOWS (2002-2011)

Arrivals (millions of persons)

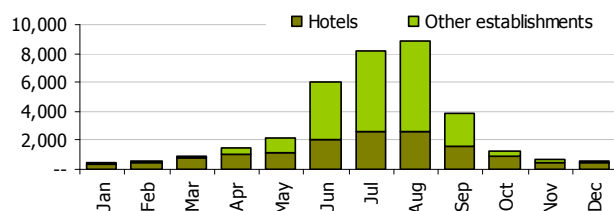

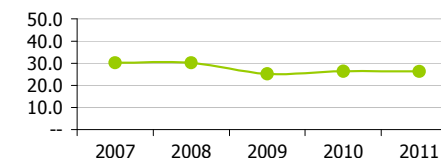

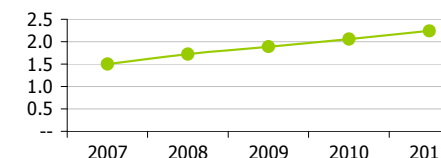

GOODS HANDLED (millions of tonnes)

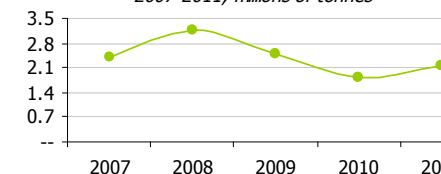


PASSENGER TRAFFIC (millions of passengers)



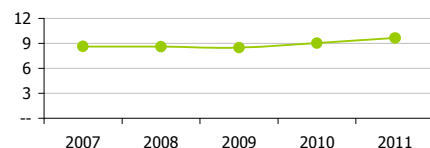
PORT OF CHIOGGIA: goods handled

2007-2011, millions of tonnes



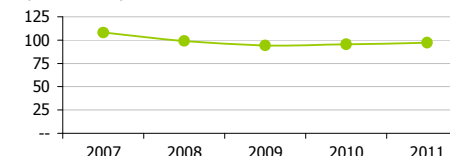
AIRPORTS OF VENICE AND TREVISO (2007-2011)

Some definitions

Handling of goods: sum of tonnes arrived (unloaded) and sent (shipped).

Passenger's traffic: total arrivals (passengers landed) and departures (passengers shipped).

Mean daily real vehicles: mean daily number of vehicles really travelling on motorway.

Light Vehicles: motorcycles with cylinder capacity greater than 150 cc; all vehicles whose height measured to the first axle is less than 1.3 m.

Heavy Vehicles: all vehicles for goods transport whose height measured to the first axle is greater than 1.3 m.

Some definitions

Loans: funds lent to economic sectors in the province. **ATM** (Automated Teller Machine): automatic machine that effect bank counter operations with:

Deposits: current accounts, deposits, conditioned liabilities deferring obligations, prompt action to meet due dates of liabilities. concurrent updating of the balance of the client's account, and other banking operations.

Bank counter: bank office where deposits and current accounts operations can be made. **POS** (Points of Sale): automatic machine at companies connected to the bank from which:

Bankruptcy: judicial procedure by which the equity of an insolvent entrepreneur is liquidated in proportion to settling the debts to creditors. automatic debits of the company's bank account can be made to pay for goods or services, and the vendor's or service provider's account credited.

Offence: action for which the main penalty is imprisonment and/or a fine or a series of additional penalties. **Protest:** formal deed to object to the refusal of the drawee to accept the bill of exchange or failure to pay the bill of exchange or to honour a bank cheque.

Prison conviction: person given a prison sentence for committing an imprisonable offence. **Source:** Bank of Italy, Istat (National Statistical Institute), Venice Court, Ministry of Justice -
