










RESIDENT POPULATION BY GENDER




INTERNAL FINAL CONSUMPTION BY TYPE



LABOUR FORCE BY GENDER


















TOURIST NIGHTS BY ORIGIN 2012, % volume




TOURIST FLOWS (2002-2012)







PORT OF VENICE (Anni 2008-2012)


GOODS HANDLED (millions of tonnes)




PASSENGER TRAFFIC (millions of passengers)
